

MINNESOTA STATE FAIR

Photography & Videography Guidelines

Individuals or crews taking photographs or video footage on the State Fairgrounds must follow the guidelines listed below:

- Impeding foot or vehicle traffic with vehicles, equipment or crew members is not allowed anywhere on the fairgrounds.
- Video footage or photography of free entertainment stage and Grandstand shows is strictly prohibited.
- The Minnesota State Fair cannot grant permission to photograph company logos on concession stands or exhibits. Photographers and videographers are responsible for seeking permission (if it is required) from the business owner/s.
- The Minnesota State Fair cannot grant permission for still photography and/or filmed interviews. Photographers and videographers are responsible for seeking permission (if it is required) from the individual being photographed or interviewed.
- Video/photographers may not enter areas marked off-limits or requiring special credentials.
- The “everyone pays” policy applies to all video/photographers and talent as it relates to admission, ride, game, attraction and Grandstand tickets, as well as food and merchandise.
