Overview

Come be a part of the Minnesota State Fair Greenhouse team! Help make the Minnesota State Fair grounds shine during the summer season and through the fair!

Essential Functions

- Assist with care and upkeep of State Fair lawns.
- Assist with care and upkeep of greenhouse and gardens, including watering, fertilizing and transplanting.
- Work environment may include working with hazardous substances, heat/cold, noise, unprotected heights, bright/dim lighting and mechanical hazards.
- Assist with tasks assigned by either the immediate supervisor or general manager as needed.

Required Qualifications

- Knowledge of annual and perennial plant characteristics.
- Ability to work independently, and to work quickly and efficiently.
- Excellent communication skills with other team members.
- Must be able to lift up to 50 lbs.
- Valid driver's license.
- Available to work end of May – September 3 with limited days off.
- Extended hours during peak times and consecutive days without time off are required. No days off during the fair, August 23 – September 3.
- Possible part-time opportunity through September.

Preferred Qualifications

- 1-2 years of experience in a horticulture field.
- Experience working in a greenhouse or horticulture setting.
- Experience with gardening equipment such as a tiller and tractor loader bucket.
